Campus Map and Directions

From the airport:

- Take I-85 North through the Downtown Connector (I-75/85 merge).
- Continue on I-85 North to Exit 89 - North Druid Hills Road. Follow directions below.

From I-85:

- Take Exit 89 - North Druid Hills Road.
- Head west approximately 2 miles, where North Druid Hills Road meets Peachtree Road. Be aware that North Druid Hills Road bears off to the right at the third traffic light.
- When you reach Peachtree Road, turn right and head north on Peachtree Road for 1 mile.
- Oglethorpe University will be on your left.

From I-285:

- Take exit 31-A, Peachtree Industrial Boulevard south.
- Head south on Peachtree Industrial Boulevard for approximately 4 miles.
- Oglethorpe University will be on your right.

From GA-400:

- Take GA-400 to I-285 east.
- Go east on I-285 for one exit to exit 29, Ashford-Dunwoody Road.
- Turn right onto Ashford-Dunwoody Road, and continue until the road meets Peachtree Road.
- Turn right on Peachtree Road.
- Oglethorpe University will be one block ahead on your right.



Athletic Training Services

On behalf of Oglethorpe University, welcome to Atlanta. We are excited to be hosting you and your team and would like to make your stay here enjoyable.

The Sports Medicine Clinic is located in the Steve Schmidt Recreation Center, which is connected to Dorough Fieldhouse and adjacent to the baseball field. A certified athletic trainer will be present at all traditional season competitions and will be available in the athletic training room two hours prior to the competition.

The Oglethorpe University athletic training staff will provide:

- Pre-game taping (please send necessary supplies)
- Medical assistance for acute injuries/illness
- Emergent care
- Modality treatments to include: moist heat, ultrasound and e-stim provided a letter detailing specific protocols is sent to our attention at least twenty-four hours prior to the competition.
